Your child will be eligible to start school in the next school year (2019/20). You should apply for a school place NOW or your child may lose out on a place at your preferred school.

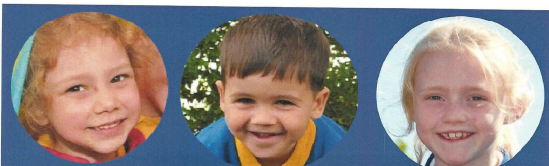

Last week we had a visit from our new Academy Improvement Adviser, Sarah Somers who is also an Ofsted inspector and works in schools all over the country. She is also the improvement adviser for the Junior School. As it was the first time she had been to our school, it was interesting to know what she thought. I am delighted to tell you that she was very impressed with the children's behaviour. She spoke to children from each year group who were an absolute credit. They were so polite! At lunch time she sat with the children and commented on how calm the hall was.

She was amazed at how well the reception children had settled into school and were already eager to learn. All the classrooms around school were very calm with all the children on task. She was particularly impressed with the writing in Year 2 and commented that it was really worth the effort of introducing the sweep up writing early as by Year 2 most of the children had a beautiful handwriting style. Obviously she found areas for improvement as she is an improvement adviser. The main thing we need to work on is ensuring all the children have a writing target and therefore know how they can improve.

Yesterday the Year 1 children went to the Safari park and had a fantastic time. Once again they were a credit to us all as their behaviour was exemplary. I am sure that Year 2 will be the same today.
