

Head Bump Procedure

We seem to be having quite a few bump notes which is causing concern, especially to some of our Reception parents. We therefore take this opportunity to explain our procedure.

When a child has a bump to the head for whatever reason, a large bump note is completed, signed off by the child's teacher and delivered to the front desk as soon as possible after the incident has happened. Parents are then sent a standard worded text message. This is simply a courtesy message. There is no need to ring in reply. The form is then completed and returned to the class teacher for handing to the parent at the end of the day. Throughout the day, we keep an eye on the child to ensure that nothing more serious develops. Should we become concerned, we will ring the parent to come and collect the child and if necessary seek medical advice. Concussion can become apparent many hours after a bumped head and it is essential therefore that parents are made aware that an incident has taken place. If you have any further questions, please speak with your class teacher.
