As there have been a few cases of conjunctivitis recently, we thought we would remind you of the School's policy regarding this. It is normal GP procedure for a child to be prescribed eye drops/cream. It is the School's policy that a child should receive treatment for 24 hours before returning to school. This helps prevent this highly contagious condition from spreading throughout a class, particularly in view of the young ages of the children at our school. As with all prescribed medicines, our School staff can administer the drops/cream throughout the day. You will however have to complete a medicine form on the first day of bringing in the medicine.
