On Monday I had a meeting with the people from Shropshire Council who are in charge of road safety. I gave them two emails I had received from parents who are very concerned about the safety of the children now that we no longer have a lollipop lady at the end of the drive. They understand the difficulties and are currently doing an audit of the area. They are going to construct some form of road calming device whether this is a crossing, bumps in the road, narrowing of the road or a 20 mile limit, they do not know at present as plans will need to go to consultation. In the meantime they have said that we can have a lollipop person. However, over the past six years Shropshire Council has not been able to recruit a lollipop person as no one has applied for the role. They are not confident that we will have any interest either. I will ask staff in school if anyone would be prepared to take on the role on a temporary basis. If anyone knows of anyone who may be interested please see me. This is not an advert for the post only an enquiry of interest.

With the present situation I am mindful that children are very vulnerable coming to and going home from school. I have spoken to the children in assembly but ultimately the children are their parents responsibility outside the school grounds. Please ensure your child stays by you at all times.

If anyone has any ideas or suggestions on how we can improve the safety please let me know. Maybe the children could wear high-vis jackets which would be helpful as the days are getting shorter.
