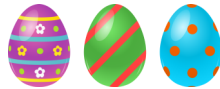


Easter Bonnet Parade

Have you started to make your Easter Bonnet yet? We are looking forward to seeing your wonderful creations on the last day of term (next Thursday) for our Easter Bonnet Parade. There will be prizes awarded for the 3 best bonnets in each class as chosen by the children.

Even if it is wet we will parade round school. Please arrive at school for 2pm. Visitors will be asked to line the route around school. The children will parade through so that everyone has chance to see the children's hats. You will then be asked to go to your child's class to meet them and join us in the parade around the block. We turn **RIGHT** at the top of the drive and walk through Poyner Close and then follow the route **ALONG** Gravel Hill and Henley Road. Nursery children are able to return to school through the Bromley Road entrance but the rest of the school will proceed to the front entrance. All children must then return to their classrooms.

Thank you for your questionnaires from last week's Parents' evenings, although we have not collated them all yet, I can see that they are very positive with only a few suggestions for improvements which can easily be taken in on board, so thank you for your input.

Next Thursday is the traditional Easter Bonnet Parade. Please encourage your child to make an Easter Bonnet and bring it into school on Thursday morning where the children in each class will judge the hats. We will then have an assembly and give out the prizes. The Easter Bonnet parade will start at 2pm. Please arrive at school just before 2pm and line the route around the school. Once everyone is in position the children will come out of their classrooms and parade around school making two circuits. They will then return to their classes. Please make your way to your child's class. The children will all come out and gather in a line from the school gate until everyone is ready. Please walk with your child round the road ensuring that your child stays safe on the pavement. We go out of the front gates and turn right, down Poyner Road, right at the end along Gravel Hill, then right at the one stop shop. Nursery children usually return to school via the back gate on Bromley Road as this is slightly shorter. After the parade children will need to go back to their classrooms to collect their belongings. They can then go home. Please take part in the Easter Bonnet parade, although we may finish before 3pm and children will be allowed to go slightly early they will not be allowed to go home during the walk as this can be confusing for the other children.

If you have a more than one child, the older children can walk with younger child's class as they have done it before and therefore understand the routine.
