Please check your child's book bag today as there is a very important letter from the Governors of the Infant and the Junior School. The information provided will be of great interest to both schools.

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As the spring has finally arrived so have the summer uniforms. We therefore need to clarify school uniform policy. For safety reasons shoes need to have low heels and secure straps. Although sandals are allowed, the straps must be behind the ankle, flip flops and shoes without backs are not allowed. For safety reasons socks must be worn as shoes can easily slip off without them.

We have noticed that the retailers are cashing into the "gingham uniform" and introducing a variety of items which look like school uniform although they are not actually part of our uniform list. Many of these items are really nice and offer something a little different, eg gingham shorts, skirts, culottes and blouses of which I do not have an issue as the children still look smart. However, the jumpsuits which some girls are wearing are not very practical for school. We have noticed that when they sit down the jumpsuits ride up and are extremely uncomfortable. Please be mindful of the length of your child's skirt as now that they are not wearing tights, when they sit crossed legged on the carpet they can be put into an embarrassing situation, particularly now that we have a male student teacher.
