

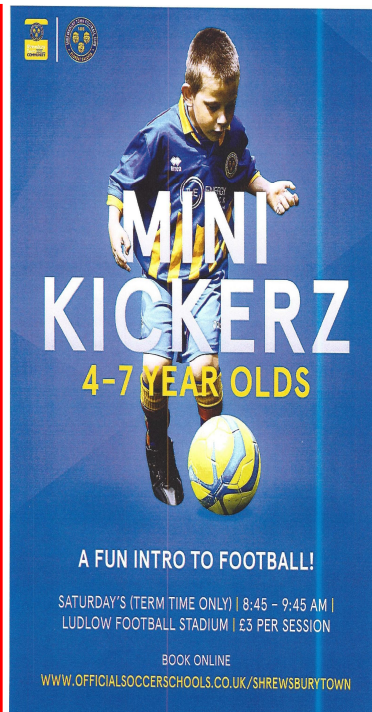
Term Time holiday
